Footnotes

NOTABLE OKIE rated off early pack along inside, worked way forwardly during run down backstretch, came three wide when making bid into lane, responded to steady urging to take command and surge clear late. SOME QUICK within striking distance along inside from outset, swung four wide into stretch, moved to loom danger mid stretch, hung near end but gamely held second spot. ARTIC HEAT within striking distance along rail from outset, swung off rail five wide into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, weakened in drive to wire. PATTON ON SPEED well back during early running moved up outside rivals into stretch, finished with a mild belated mid track rally. CALL RICK FOR HELP in middle of pack throughout, lacked needed response in drive. BOOGIE MUSIC along inside in mid pack, made no bid. DARING CHILD vied with early leaders on the outside to top stretch, gave way. OKLAHOMA TRADITION sent to front, set pace along rail for three quarters, faded. SHEIK OF WAGONER failed to menace. BLUMIN CRAFTY chased pace for three quarters, dropped back in lane. MAJOR MITCH was always outrun.
