

HISA Rule 2276 Horseshoes

(a) Except for full rims 2mm or less from the ground surface of the Horseshoe, traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb Horseshoes during racing and training on dirt or synthetic racing tracks.

(b) Traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb Horseshoes during training and racing on turf.

(c) Traction devices include but are not limited to rims, toe grabs, bends, jar chinks and stickers.

UPDATE

Rule 2276 shall not be enforced for horses racing on dirt surfaces that are shod on the hind limbs with traction devices in the form of either a full outer rim shoe (up to 4 mm in height) or a toe grab (up to 4 mm in height).

All other provisions of **Rule 2276** shall remain in full force and effect.
