

CRITERIA FOR HORSES TO ENTERING REMINGTON PARK

All horses entering Remington Park must have a **NEGATIVE** coggins test conducted within 12 months that should have been drawn after December 13, 2023. The coggins test must be the **original** or **certified lab copy** showing correct and complete ownership. In Oklahoma a copy of a negative coggins will no longer suffice according to the state. It is illegal to run a horse in Oklahoma with a copy. The OHRC enforces this law.

The trainer is responsible for insuring that a negative coggins test is on file in the Racing Secretary's office for all horses stabled and/or competing at Remington Park. Failure to comply subjects the licensee to disciplinary action.

Important updates that concern all Oklahoma horsemen transporting and racing horses at Remington Park.

EHV-1 and Vesicular Stomatitis Policy for ALL Horses coming to Remington Park

ALL horses coming into the Remington Park stable area must have a current health certificate prior to arrival at the track which shows they've been vaccinated with an FDA approved modified live or killed virus vaccine for EHV-1, not less than 14 days, and not more than 90 days, prior to the date of entry into the stable gate. The veterinarian issuing the health certificate must provide the date of the EHV-1 vaccination, brand, serial number, expiration date of vaccine, and temperature of each horse. Current (within last 12 months) negative Equine Infectious Anemia test information (date and accession number) must be listed for each horse on certificate. The health certificate must contain a statement by the issuing veterinarian that they have physically examined each horse listed on this certificate within five (5) days of shipment date, and the horses do not exhibit any clinical signs of EHV-1 and/or Vesicular Stomatitis, and the veterinarian has verified with the owner/trainer that the horses have not been exposed to a suspected EHV-1 or Vesicular Stomatitis positive horse or premise within the last 14 days.

THE ABOVE CRITERIA MUST BE MET FOR THE HORSE(S) TO ENTER AT REMINGTON PARK
